

FAQs on RFGI membership

Q. Is the membership free to be paid annually?

A. No. The membership fee is a one-time payment to be made by those who wish to become members. However, RFGI will also request for voluntary donations from their members every year.

Q. Would we still receive the updates from RFGI if we do not pay our one time membership fee?

A. After 31st July 2010, those who do not pay their one-time membership fee will only be sent invitations for RFGI events and no other emails/updates.

Q. What benefits will I get if I become a member?

A. Once you become a member, you will be entitled to receive personalised emails/updates of RFGI activities. Members will be able to attend certain paid events of RFGI free of cost and participate in core-group activities. They will also receive discount on RFGI publications.

Q. What if I cannot pay through cheque/debit card?

A. In that case, we will be happy to provide our bank details to you for paying directly to our bank account. Kindly send an email with a request of the same. We will also be putting up the paypal service on our website shortly for those who wish to pay online.

Q. What is the membership fee?

A. The membership fee is Rs. 100 for students and Rs. 250 for non-students.

Q. What if I am outside India and still want to become a member?

A. For those who are out of India, the membership fees are \$10 for students and \$25 for non-students.

Q. Will the money be refunded if we want to discontinue the membership?

A. Since RFGI is a volunteer driven organisation, the membership money will be used for organising various events and activities. The details of the finances will be put up on our website shortly.
